

When you visit, please be sure to close the window of the tabernacle if no one will be visiting Our Lord when you leave.



Pro Life News From Conception until Natural Death:

Week 36:

Your baby's lungs are fully formed and ready to take their first breath after the birth. The digestive system is fully developed and your baby will be able to feed if they're born now.

Week 37:

Your pregnancy is considered full-term. The average baby weighs around 3-4kg by now. Your baby is ready to be born, and you'll be meeting them some time in the next few weeks.

Your baby's gut (digestive system) now contains meconium - the sticky green substance that will form your baby's first poo after birth. It may include bits of the lanugo (fine hair) that covered your baby earlier in pregnancy.

Week 38:

If your baby does a poo during labor, which can sometimes happen, the amniotic fluid will contain meconium. If this is the case, your midwife will want to monitor your baby closely as it could mean the baby is stressed.

Week 39:

In the last weeks, some time before birth, the baby's head should move down into your pelvis. When your baby's head moves down like this, it's said to be "engaged". When this happens, you may notice your bump seems to move down a little. Sometimes the head does not engage until labor starts.

Week 40:

The fine hair (lanugo) that covered your baby's body is now almost all gone, although some babies may have small patches of it when they're born.

Usually by this time your baby is born via vaginal birth, or caesarean. Each birth is unique in the individual and doctor/ midwife.

Soon you will be enjoying your bundle of joy that is just a Miracle from God!!


